RESOLUTION NO. 46-2015

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL MAYOR DORIS E. MANIQUIZ-JERESANO TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL WELFARE AND DEVELOPMENT (DSWD) FIELD OFFICE III, CITY OF SAN FERNANDO, PAMPANGA FOR THE TRANSFER OF FUNDS FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF CASH FOR WORK PROJECTS AND ACTIVITIES FOR CLIMATE CHANGE ADAPTATION AND MITIGATION.

WHEREAS, the projects aligned on the Climate Change Adaptation and Mitigation (CCAM) are priority programs for Calendar Year 2015 along with risk resiliency aimed in strengthening the resiliency of the natural ecosystem and adaptive capacities of vulnerable groups and communities to short and long term risks.

WHEREAS, these Cash for Work projects and activities with long term impact on the development of the physical and natural assets of the recipient-communities which may include, but limited to the following projects including mitigation measures such as rehabilitation of mangrove plantation, tree planting or reforestation activities, and rehabilitation of small-scale community infrastructure such as slope protection, desilting of waterways and others.

WHEREAS, the project aims to encourage the individuals listed in the cash for work to prepare for the ill effects of climate change being seen around the world, secondary to prevent any environmental damages that is caused by natural or man made phenomenon, like coastal or riverside erosion, and provide the same groups an opportunity to work for their respective daily food requirements through these projects.

WHEREAS, the DSWD Field Office III, City of San Fernando, Pampanga had allocated an amount of P 3,298,680.00 for the implementation of cash for work (CFW) projects which will include the participation of 1,309 poor individuals to render time and effort for ten days, with an amount of P 252.00 as daily rate.

WHEREAS, once the project is completed, the project beneficiaries had made such initiatives and measures to reduce the vulnerability of the natural and human system against actual or expected climate change effects.

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of Honorable Atty. Noel S. Ferrer, duly seconded by Hon. Aris George D. Lingat and approved by all the members present.

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, that the amount of Three Million Two Hundred Ninety Eight Thousand Six Hundred Eighty Pesos (P3,298,680.00) for the implementation of the cash for projects, be transferred to the Office of the Municipal Treasurer, Local Government Unit of Botolan, Zambales, from DSWD Field Office III, Maimpis, City of San Fernando, Pampanga.
