# RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE LOCAL ANTI-CRIMINALITY PLAN (LACAP) AGAINST ILLEGAL DRUGS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BOTOLAN, ZAMBALES

Whereas, the National Head Quarters (NHQ), Philippine National Police (PNP) issued loi 71/08 "Payapa" Decentralizing and formulation and implementation of Anti-Criminality Action Plans and LOIU 70/80 'Local Anti-Crime Strategy and Policy Focus of the Chief, PNP";

Whereas, the Botolan Police Station recorded a successful illegal drug operations with seventy five (75) drug cases filed at the Office of the Prosecutor;

Whereas, there is a need to strengthen intelligence and information gathering by providing rewards to civilian agent who could provide information leading to the arrest of drug personalities within this municipality;


**Now therefore**, on motion of Hon. Garry R. Guevarra, Chairman of the Committee on Peace and Order, seconded by Hon. Dr. Fernando D. Igrobay, and approved by all the members;

Resolved, as it hereby resolved, that this Body hereby adopts the following:

# THE LOCAL ANTI-CRIMINALITY ACTION PLAN (LACAP) AGAINST ILLEGAL DRUGS IN THIS MUNICIPALITY

### A. MISSION

PNP-BOTOLAN, concurrent with its mission and functions, in close coordination with its friendly forces, LGUs, and NGOs shall identify and neutralize personality/group engaged in illegal drugs activities and all identified suspects will be subsequently charged for the offense committed and put behind bars.





- e. Traffic/Patrol Section
- Standby force ready on call during buy-bust operations
- 2. 33<sup>rd</sup> Mechanized Brigade, Philippine Army and 3<sup>rd</sup> Maneuver Platoon, Provincial Public Safety Company (PPSC)
- Provide additional personnel as augmentation to PNP-Botolan if necessary during the conduct of police anti-criminality campaign and
  - Perform other tasks as necessary
- 3. Botolan Rural Health Unit
  - Provide ambulance with crew on standby during the conduct of drug operations and
  - Perform other tasks as necessary
- 4. Botolan Treasurer's Office
  - Request to provide the necessary funding in the implementation of this LACAP;
- The funding requirements for the effective and successful implementation of this plan are:

Monetary reward for civilian informer	
For every anti-illegal drugs operation	Php1,000.00
Miscellaneous expenses of Intel	-
Agents/Operatives	3,500.00
TOTAL	4,500.00

- 5. Botolan Municipal Peace and Order (MPOC)
  - Convene the council members for inputs and subsequent approval of the Anti-Criminality Action Plan taking into consideration the responsibility of all concerned for a holistic and effective approach to the crime situation.
  - Recommend for the funding support for its implementation; and
  - Recommend to convene the MADAC and BADAC for purpose
- 6. Sangguniang Bayan of Botolan
  - evaluate annually the implementation of this resolution
  - appropriate funds in the annual budget
- 7. Coordinating Instructions
  - a. Operational security shall be observed at all times
- b. Coordination with the PDEA, BADAC, and MADAC and other law enforcement agencies as well as nearby MPS on the identification of drug personalities
  - c. Need to know basis shall be directly observed.
  - d. Coordination with other Intel and Investigation units is highly encouraged
  - e. Respect for human rights shall be strictly observed.
- f. Observance and compliance of all legal requirements pertinent to law enforcement and police operations shall be an integral part in the concept of this LACAP.



## B. EXECUTION

Concepts of Operations

The measures to be undertaken are the following:

- 1. PNP-Botolan in coordination with LGUs, NGOs, different sectors of the community and other stakeholders shall set guidelines/procedures on decentralizing the formulation and implementation of this LACAP.
- 2. Conduct of continuous dialogues in all barangays and concerned sectors of the community as part of education and public drive to engender their awareness and support in the implementation of this LACAP.
- 3. Conduct of at least 1 police operations/drug buy-bust operation per week to apprehend all drug personalities operating in AOR in coordination with PDEA, MADAC and BADAC and other stakeholders.
  - b. Task
  - 1. PNP-Botolan
  - a. Operations Section
    - Assist the COP in the implementation of this LACAP
- Coordinate with the LGUs and SB Office for the passage of corresponding Municipal Resolution/Ordinance and other initiatives with similar and complementary objectives.
- Review and improve the conduct of buy-bust operations for the successful future operations and
  - Perform other tasks as necessary
  - b. Intelligence Section
- Provide timely and accurate intelligence information to all tasked personnel and updated target list and watch list of drug personalities in AOR.
- Monitor the plans/activities of all drug personalities operating within AOR and
  - Perform other tasks as necessary
  - c. Investigation Section
- Undertake case build-up and documentation for the filing of cases and their prosecution
  - Supervise the investigation and disposition of cases filed and
  - Perform other tasks as necessary
  - d. Police Community Relations (PCR) Section
- Conduct public information campaign in coordination with the Municipal Public Information Officer, in order to raise public awareness and generate the community support in the fight against illegal drugs
- Coordinate with all barangay officials for the mobilization of BPATs, Barangay Information Net (BIN), eye in the Barangay as force multipliers and
  - Perform other tasks as necessary

Resolved further, that the Local Anti-Criminality Plan (LACAP) against illegal drugs in the Municipality of Botolan, Zambales shall be implemented upon approval by the Municipal Mayor.

Resolved furthermore, that copies of this resolution be furnished the Chief of Police, the Local Finance Committee, MLGOO, this Municipality for their information and appropriate action.
